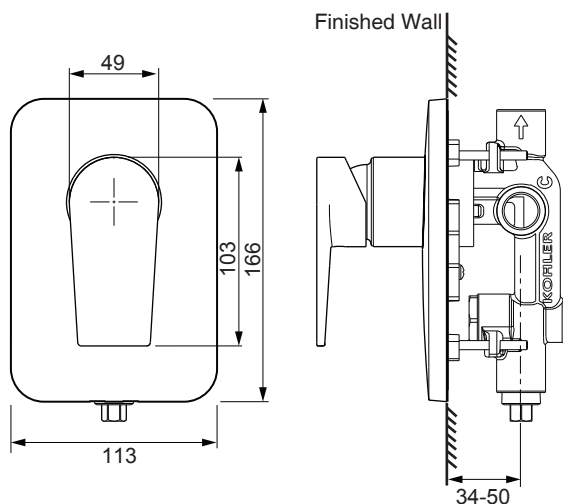
NOTES:

1. Flush the water supply pipes thoroughly to remove debris.
2. Do not remove the plaster guard from the valve body until instructed to.
3. Install valve 880* according to the rough-in dimensions of 74039T-4FP, install valve 882* according to the rough-in dimensions of 74041T-4FP.

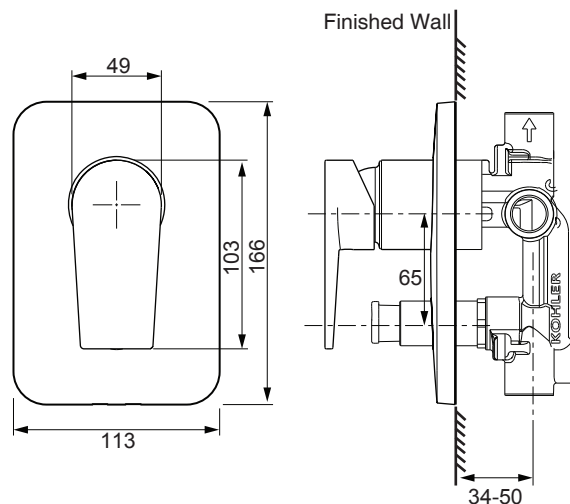
ROUGH-IN DIMENSIONS

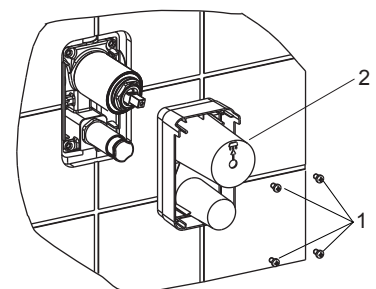


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INSTALLATION

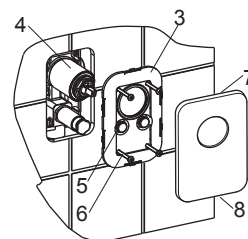
NOTES: Install valve 880* according to the rough-in dimensions of 74039T-4FP, install valve 882* according to the rough-in dimensions of 74041T-4FP.

Loosen the screws (1), and remove the plaster guard (2) after completed the finished wall.



For 74039T-4FP

Slide the cover kit (3) onto the valve (4) with the plug (5) facing outside. Push it against the wall. Secure it with the screw (6). Slide the faceplate (7) onto the valve with slots (8) downwards. Then push it against the wall.

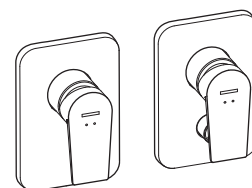
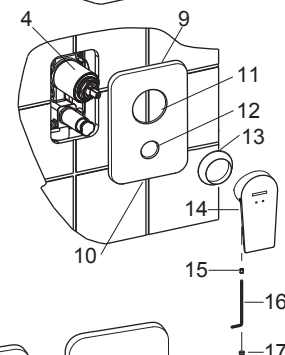


For 74041T-4FP

Apply a ring of plumbers putty around the back surface of the faceplate (9). Slide the faceplate onto the valve (4) with slots (10) downwards. Then push it against the wall.

NOTE: Don't squeeze out the rings (11,12).

Screw the bonnet (13) on the valve. Install the handle (14) on the valve stem. Tighten the screw (15) with the hex wrench (16). Press plug button (17) to the hole.



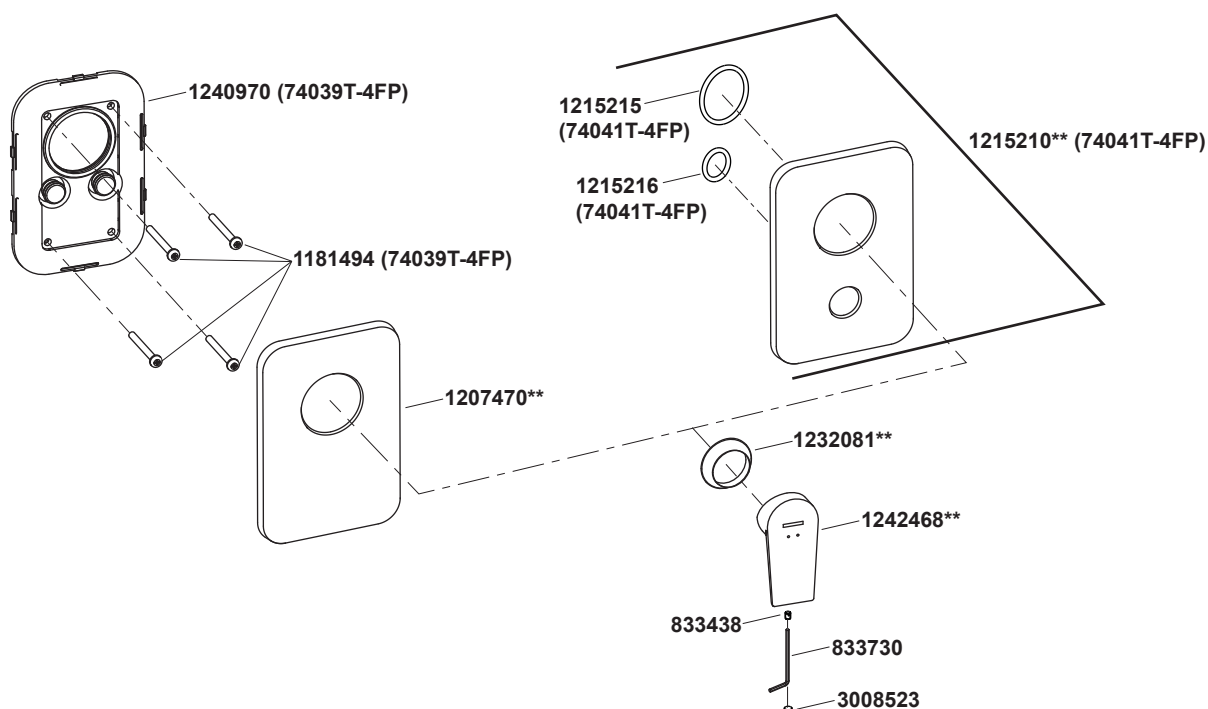
The illustration shown is the correct position of the handle in the closed position.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

All Finishes: Clean the finish with mild soap and warm water. Wipe entire surface completely dry with clean soft cloth. Many cleaners may contain chemicals, such as ammonia, chlorine, toilet cleaner etc, which could adversely affect the finish and are not recommended for cleaning.

Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents on Kohler faucets and fittings.
