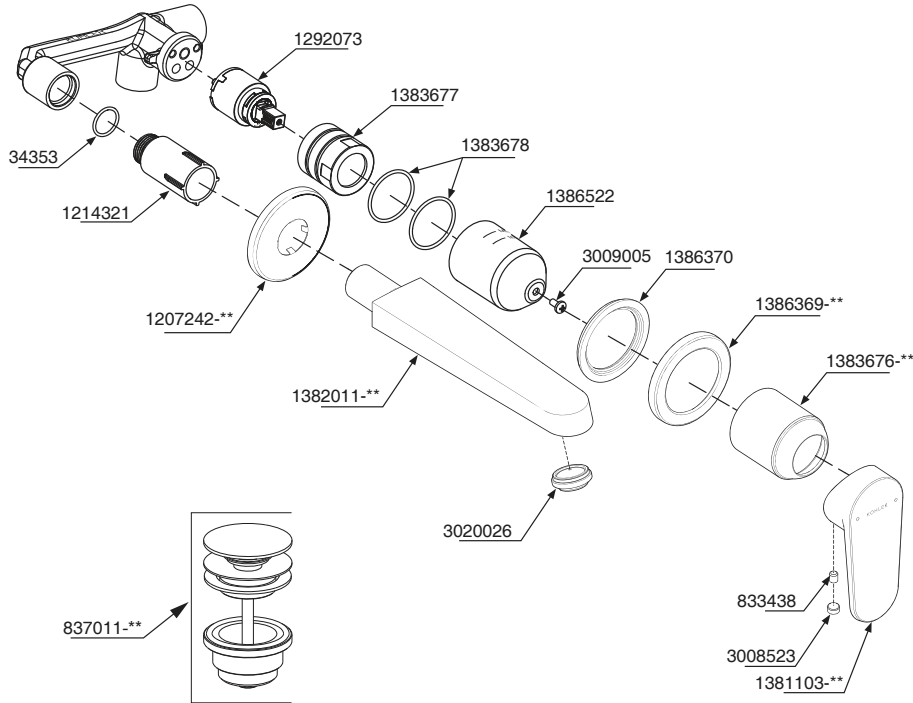

NOTES:

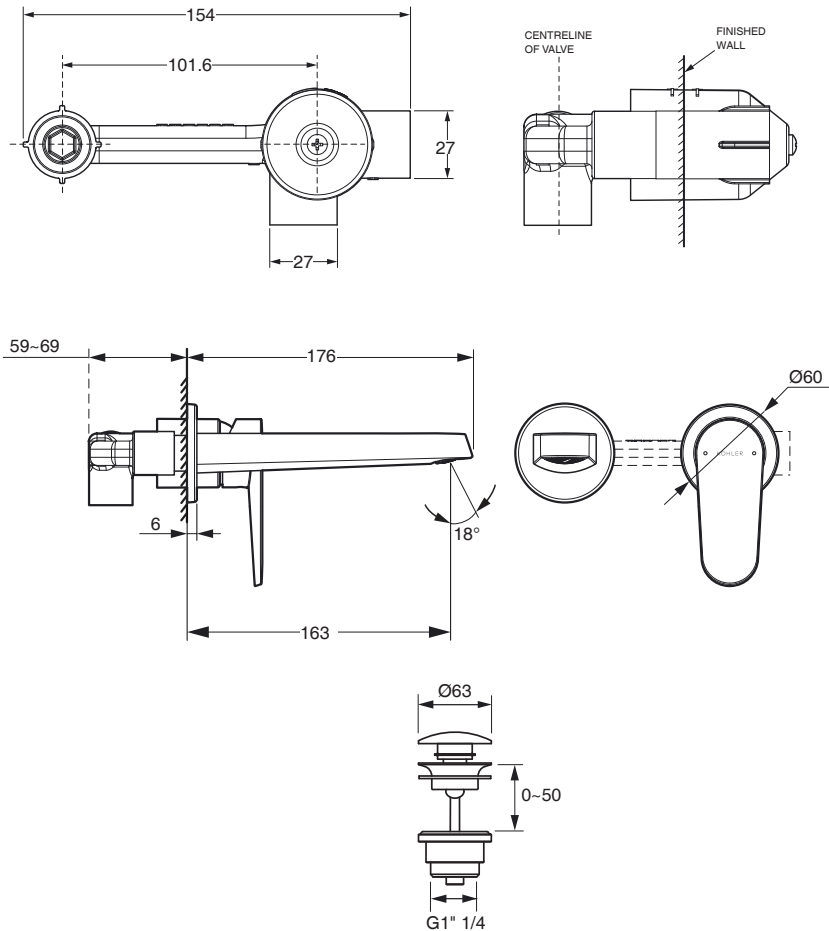
1. Flush the water supply pipe thoroughly to remove debris.
2. If possible, install this faucet before installing the lavatory
3. Inspect the supply tubing for damage and leakage. Replace and maintain as necessary.
4. Observe all local plumbing and building codes.
5. Shut off the water supply to the fitting.

HANDLE OPERATION

Lift handle gently. Turn clockwise for hot water, turn counterclockwise for cold water.

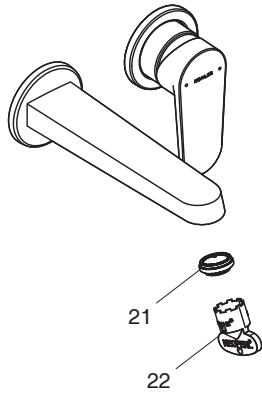

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INSTALLATION CHECKOUT



Ensure that all connections are tight. Ensure that the handle is in the off position. Turn on the drain and main water supply, and check for leaks. Repair as needed.

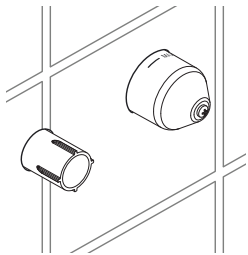
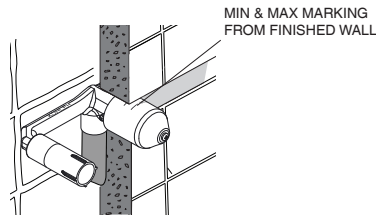
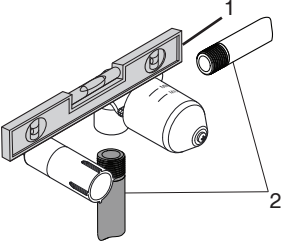
Remove the aerator(21) by key(22). Turn on the faucet. Run hot and cold water through the spout for about one minute to remove any debris. Remove debris from the aerator. Shut off the faucet and reinstall the aerator.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

All Finishes: Clean the finish with mild soap and warm water. Wipe entire surface completely dry with clean soft cloth. Many cleaners may contain chemicals, such as ammonia, chlorine, toilet cleaner etc, which could adversely affect the finish and are not recommended for cleaning.

Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents on Kohler faucets and fittings.

INSTALLATION



How to Install the Valve

Determine where the valve will be located on the wall. Dig a suitable hole in the wall. Install the valve with the help of level gauge(1), so that it should be perpendicular to wall. Connect the hot(2)and cold(2) water supply pipes to the valve.

Ensure no leakage. Maintain finished wall surface as per Min-Max marking. Finish the valve installation by cementing and tiling the wall.

Figure shows the position of valves when its installation completed.

How to Install the Spout

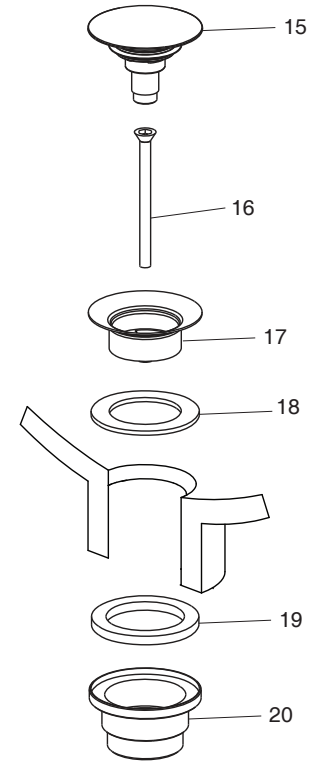
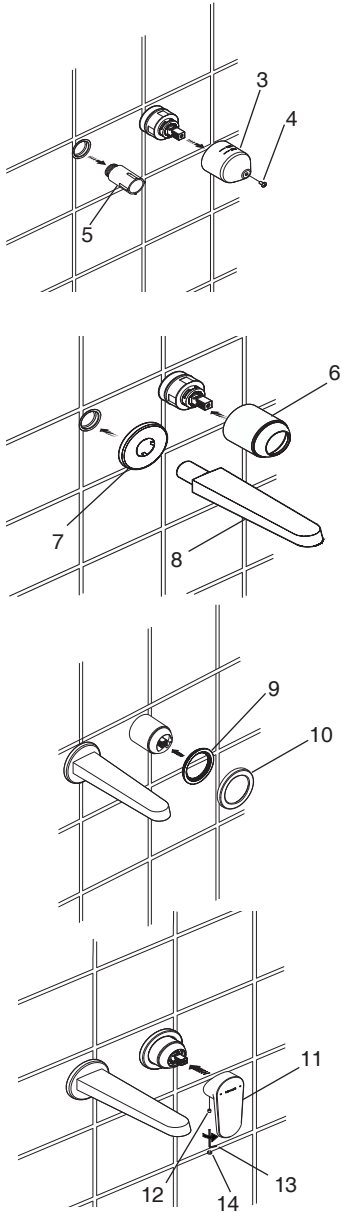
Loosen the screw(4) and remove the plaster guard(3) from the valve. Pull out the plaster(5) from valve outlet.

Install bonnet(6) onto the valve. Insert the escutcheon(7) on the spout(8) and push the spout(8) into the valve outlet.

Put the gasket(9) into the rear groove of the escutcheon bases(10). Mount the escutcheon(10) on the wall.

Install handle(11) over the bonnet and secure using supplied set screw(12). carefully tighten set screw (12) with the help of allen key (13).

Install cap(14).



How to Install the Drain

Remove the stopper(15) from the top waste(17). Install the top waste with the foam washer(18) into the drain hole. Put the rubber washer(19, tapered side up) into the groove of the bottom waste (20). Align the top waste(17) with the bottom waste(20), screw the stud(16) through the hole of the top waste and bottom waste with hexagon wrench. Then screw the stopper into the top waste.

NOTE: If needed, apply a ring of plumbers putty around the underside of the drain body, instead of using washer(18). Place cover(15) into drain body.
