

## **Prepare the Site**

#### Old Bath Removal



- $\square$  Disconnect the drain at the trap.
- ☐ Remove the old material. Slip the floor protection boards under the old bath feet to protect the floor.
- ☐ Slide the old bath out of the recess as shown.

#### **Subfloor Preparation**

**NOTE:** Provide adequate floor support. Refer to the Roughing-in Sheet packed with the bath for specific floor load requirements.

- ☐ Check the floor under the bath and make repairs as needed.
- ☐ Verify that the subfloor is at level.


#### **Plumbing Preparation**

- $\hfill\square$  Position the plumbing according to rough-in dimensions.
- ☐ Check the supplies for leaks.

# **Preparation of Bath**

<u> </u>	<b>CAUTION: Risk of product or property damage.</b> Do not support the bath by the apron.
	Follow all the local plumbing and building codes.
	Install the bath on a level floor.
	Provide properly dimensioned space.
	Verify that the flooring offers adequate support for your bath. The floor below the bath must have the capacity to support a minimum load of $1102\ lb$ (500 kg), which includes the combined weight of the bath, water, and one user.
Pr	oduct Inspection
	Unpack and inspect the bath for damage. Leave all the materials in the crate during construction to prevent damage.
	Carefully open the accessory cartons and remove the components and hardware pack.
	If you find any damage, do not install the bath or the accessory. Report the specific problem to your dealer. $$
Ве	fore Installing the Unit
	Position the protective cover or similar material in the bottom of the unit. Be careful not to scratch the bath surface.
	Flush the water supply pipes thoroughly to remove the debris.
	Inspect the supply tubing for damage. Replace if required.

# 1. Unpack the Bath



- $\hfill \square$  For baths with a base: Carefully lift the bath by the bath rim.
- ☐ Set the bath at the desired location.

# 2. Adjust the Bath Feet




**NOTE:** The weight of the bath must be supported by the bath feet.

- $\hfill \square$  Verify that the bath is level.
- ☐ Adjust the bath feet as needed.

## 3. Install the Bath Drain Pipe



- ☐ Use the lifting straps to carefully lift the bath off the floor.
- ☐ Insert the bath drain pipe into the waste pipe. Seal the gap between the bath drain pipe and waste pipe with silicone filler.

### 4. Install the Overflow Trim and Drain Trim




**NOTE:** The illustations show a bath with a shroud bath. The steps apply to baths with a shroud and to baths with a base.

- ☐ Insert the drain cover and drain trim into the drain body.
- ☐ Insert the overflow trim into the drain overflow plate.
- ☐ Press the drain trim several times to verify that the drain opens and closes properly.

## **Grab Bar Option**

- ☐ For the bath with grab bar holes, apply silicone sealant to the grab bar holes before installing the grab bar.
- ☐ Install the grab bar on the bath according to the grab bar manufacturer's instructions.

## 5. Complete the Installation



**NOTE:** The illustations show a bath with a shroud bath. The steps apply to baths with a shroud and to baths with a base.

**NOTE:** Always use a clear or color-matching silicone sealant for aesthetic appearance.

- ☐ Fill the bath with water and check for leaks.
- □ Apply a thin, continuous bead of sealant along the seam between the bath and the finished floor.
- ☐ When cleaning up after installation, do not use abrasive cleaners.
- ☐ Abrasive cleaners may scratch and dull the bath surface.
- ☐ Use warm water and a liquid nonabrasive detergent to clean the surface.

En	ameled Surfaces
	When cleaning up after installation, do not use abrasive cleaners.
	Abrasive cleaners may scratch and dull the bath surface.
	Use warm water and a liquid nonabrasive detergent to clean the surface.
	Remove stubborn stains, paint, or tar with turpentine or paint thinner.
	Remove the plaster by scraping with a wooden edge. Do not use metal scrapers, wire brushes, or other metal tools. You can use powder-type detergent on a damp cloth to provide mild abrasive action to any residual plaster.
	Clean the inside surface of your enameled cast iron product with mild soap and warm water. Wipe the entire surface completely with a clean, dry cloth.
Ac	rylic Surfaces
	Do not clean acrylic surfaces with abrasive cleaners, as they will scratch the surface and make the surface dull.
	Wipe out the bath with a clean, dry cloth after each use to prevent a build-up of scum and soap.
	If the acrylic surface becomes dull, use an automative type of rubbing compound followed by an application of wax paste.
NO	OTE: The recommended rubbing compound is Green oil.

#### **Paint Surfaces**

 $\square$  Do not clean paint surfaces with abrasive cleaners, as they will scratch the surface and make the surface dull.

 $\square$  Wipe out the bath with a clean, dry cloth after each use to prevent a build-up of scum and soap.

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
