KOHLER India's Faucets* used in commercial settings are warranted to be free of defects in material and workmanship for five years from date of purchase. If, in the opinion of Kohler India, the defect is due to defects in material or workmanship, Kohler India will, for a period of 7 (seven) years, for faucets used in residential settings, and for 5 (five) years, for faucets used in commercial settings, from the date of sale of the Faucet to the original purchaser ('warranty period'), at its sole option, repair or replace free of cost, any defective component or part of the Faucet, subject to the terms and conditions described below:

- Kohler India or its Authorized Service Franchisee alone can service/repair the Faucet.
- Proof of purchase (original sales receipt) must be provided with all warranty claims or requests.
- The service/repair of the warranty shall be provided only within the municipal limits of the town or city where the branch office of Kohler India or Authorized Service Franchisee is located.

- 6. This warranty remains applicable only if the Faucet has at all times been used strictly in accordance with the terms of this warranty and has not been improperly or negligently handled. This warranty does not cover problems arising from insufficient water pressure, excessive water impurities or improper care and cleaning**. Kohler is not responsible for labor charges, installation or other incidental or consequential costs. In no event shall the liability of Kohler India exceed the purchase price of the Faucet. Improper care and cleaning will void the warranty.
- 7. In the event of any repairs/replacement of any parts of the Faucet, this warranty shall thereafter continue and remain in force only for the unexpired period of the warranty. Any time consumed for the repair/ replacement of parts including transit of the Faucet or its parts or any period during which the Faucet has not been used whether under warranty or otherwise shall not be excluded from the warranty period.

Care and cleaning guidelines for chrome and Vibrant® PVD colors/finishes


- Do not use cleaners containing ammonia, bleach, or acid.
- Use a mild detergent (such as dishwashing soap). Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Rinse and be sure to wipe the entire surface dry.

The ideal cleaning technique is to always blot dry any water from metal surfaces. Allowing water to evaporate on metal will form water deposits. It is important to use a dabbing action to dry metal; not an abrasive or rubbing action. Cleaning with a damp sponge and buff drying should keep your faucet looking beautiful.



Cleaning

INSTALLATION

Before you Begin

- 1. Make sure that the bottle trap is installed by a competent installer.
- Turn off the water supply.
- The plumbing installation must comply with Building Regulations or any particular regulations and practices, specified by the local water company or water undertakers.
- 4. Before installation carefully inspect the item for any signs of damage. 1074205-IN2-A

- Fit the washer to the end of the bottle trap, and screw the bottle trap into the main body.
- Fit a nut onto the wider end of the plastic pipe.

Install the Bottle Trap and Extension

- Fit a nut onto the wider end of the adjustable inlet, then insert the inlet into the plastic pipe.
- Insert the plastic pipe into the bottle trap and hand tighten the nut to secure in position.
- Fit the flat washer onto the top of the nut on the adjustable inlet, and screw the assembly onto the bottom of the basin, making sure all connections are tight.
- 6. Measure the distance from the main body to the waste outlet in the wall.
- 7. If the extension pipe needs to be cut to fit, then do this now.
- Fit a nut to one end of the extension pipe then fit the conical washer onto the nut, tapered end first. Screw the extension pipe securely into the main body.
- Attach the wall flange to the other end of the extension pipe, and secure this end to the waste pipe using a suitable connector. Tighten securely.

Finish the Installation

- Make sure that all the connections are tight.
- Check for any leaks.
